## ITINERARY

### Day 1: Arrival AtParo

Arrive at Paro Airport, The one and only international airport of Bhutan with picturesque landing. After the meet and greet transfer to Thimpu, the capital city of Bhutan. Check in at the hotel in Thimpu. Overnight stay at the Thimpu.

### Day 2: Thimpu – City Tour

After Breakfast, enjoy the city tour of Thimpu covering – Tashichodrong” fortress of the glorious religion” it was initially built in 1641 and later rebuilt in its present form by King JigmeDorjiWangchuk in 1965. The Dzong houses, main secretariat building which houses the throne room of His Majesty, the King of Bhutan. Later Visit The National Memorial Chorten. Here you can witness the majestic paintings and statues inside which provide a deep insight into Buddhist philosophy. Next visit ChangangkhaLhakhang Monastery, It is a fortress like temple and monastic school perched on a ridge above Thimphu, south of Motithang. The central statue here is Chenrezig in a manifestation with 11 heads. From temple courtyard, there is fascinating view of Thimphu valley. Post lunch visit the National Zoo which also houses national animal takin. Enjoy the evening at Buddha point. Overnight stay at the Thimpu.

### Day 3: Thimpu – Punakha/Wangdue (Approx3hrs )

After Breakfast, Drive to Punakha, There are splendid views of the distant Himalayas at Dochula pas (alt. 3,050m) on Thimphu – Punakha road. Visit ChimiLhakhang - The ChimiLhakhang, situated on a hillock in the centre of the valley, is dedicated to Lama DrukpaKuenley. This temple is also known as the temple of fertility. Also visit PunakhaDzong - Built strategically at the junction of Pho Chhu and Mo Chhu rivers. The Dzong is open for visitors during Punakha festival and in summer months when the monk body moves to Thimphu. On arrival check in at the hotel. Evening free for leisure. Overnight stay at Punakha/Wangdue.

#### **Day 4: Excursion ToGangtey**

After Breakfast, drive to Gangtey valley - flat valley without any trees after the hard climb through dense forests is augmented by an impression of vast space, and extremely rare experience in Bhutan where most of the valley's are tightly enclosed. A few kilometers beyond the GangteyGoempa Monastery, on the valley floor lies the village of Phobjikha. This place is the winter home of black necked cranes that migrate from the arid plains in the north to pass winter in milder and lower climate. Evening return back to Punakha/Wangdue.Overnight Stay at Punakha/Wangdue.

#### **Day 5: Punakha To Paro( Approx 4 Hrs )**

After Breakfast,transfer to Paro. Visit Ta Dzong- One time watch tower built to defend RinpungDozng during inter-valley wars of the 17th century, since 1967 Ta Dzong is serving as the National Museum of the country. It holds fascinating collection of art, relics, religious thangkha paintings and Bhutan's exquisite postage stamps. After Ta Dzong walk down the trail of RinpungDzong - the first National Museum spiritual and temporal ruler of Bhutan, the Dzong houses the monastic body of Paro, the office of the Dzongda (district administrative head) and Thrimpon (judge) of Paro district. The approach to the Dzong is through a traditional covered bridge called NemiZam. A walk through the bridge, over a stone inlaid path, offers a good view of the architectural wonder of the DDzong as well as life around it. Visit KyichuLhakhang -It is one of the oldest and most sacred shrines of the Kingdom dating back to 7th century. From there you will be taken to the DrugyalDzong(Bhutan Victory Fort), which was built in 1646 to commemorate Bhutan's victory over Tibetan invaders during the 1600s. On a clear day you can see Mount Jumolhari, Bhutan's second-highest mountain at 7,314meters. Overnight stay at Paro.

#### **Day 6: Paro – Excursion ToChele-La-Pass**

After breakfast, drive to Chele-la pass. After driving through blue pine & rhododendron forest for 45 km, reach Chele-la pass ( 4200 meters). From this point one can have a superb views of Mt. Chomolhari&JichuDrakey. Return back to Paro. Overnight stay at Paro.

#### **Day 7: Paro Airport**

Today in time please set foot for bagdodra Airport to board onward flight by reporting Before 2-Hrs. With sweet memories of Bhutan ----- Tour End.

#### **INCLUSIONS**

- Accommodation on twin sharing basis on food plan stated above.
- All transfers and sightseeing arrangements by Private Car A/C as per itinerary.
- Vehicle at your disposal as per the itinerary.
- Driver Allowance, toll, parking fee, Night halt charges, inter- state permit and govt. applicable service tax.
- Child below 5 years on Complimentary basis.
- All applicable taxes.

## **TERMS CONDITION**

### **RESERVATION POLICY**

- 50% of the package cost to be paid at the time of booking the Package.
- 50% to be paid 05 days prior to the commencement of the trip.

### **CANCELLATION POLICY**

- In case of cancellation 30 days prior to the commencement of the trip, 30% of the deposited amount shall be deducted as cancellation charges.
- In case of cancellation 15 days prior to the commencement of the trip, 50% of the deposited amount shall be deducted as cancellation charges.
- In case of cancellation 07 days prior to the commencement of the trip, 100% of the deposited amount shall be deducted as cancellation charges.

- Sightseeing points remain closed on government holidays.
- In Bhutan, Indian and vegetarian food is difficult to get, hence major hotel will not have buffet spread for breakfast and dinner. They believe in waste not so requesting guests to believe the same and enjoy the hospitality.
- Permit office ( Phuentshilong) will be closed on Saturday and Sunday. So requesting to plan your trip in between Mondays to Thursday if coming via Road.
- Must keep your original photo Identity proof with you.
- Your Itinerary will be strictly on timings.
- The above program is only indicative and the passenger has to verify each day's program from the Driver. Please co- ordinate with your Driver for extra pick time from your hotel for each departure or sightseeing and request to follow the same very strictly.
- In every city please take the contact numbers of your Driver and your hotels.
- All Hotels and Services are confirmed as per the Itinerary No Amendments will make upon Arrival.
